Impact Funding

While ECI remains committed to long-term, sustainable change, the 2021 eruption of Mt. Nyiragongo brought sudden and extreme challenges to many of our partners and communities. Beyond being the first to provide clean water, we implemented a two-phase response to both serve immediate needs and invest in a stronger recovery.



households provided essential supplies like food and soap



children reunited with their families



children provided school supplies, uniforms, and tuition



In addition to the highlights above:

- **5 legal clinics** were established to assist displaced people
- 100 young people participated in entrepreneurship training
- 45 survivors of rape and women who suffered injuries during childbirth were relocated to safe-houses with full-service intensive care
- 2 businesses were established to respond to future recovery, included a startup that turns volcanic rock into construction-grade blocks




We're proving essential services can self-sustain in eastern Congo.


Clean Water and High Quality Health Care
